<p>The club Bylaws and Operating Rules of the University of Michigan Flyers place requirements and restrictions on member status changes. All member status changes must be for a period of at least three (3) months. Changing status after less than three (3) months requires that the member be charged dues for those months at the highest rate for the classes involved. For example, changing from Flying to Associate and</p>	<p>back in less than three (3) months will require payment of Flying dues for the months spent on Associate status. Members must settle all outstanding accounts with the club before changing to Flying status or terminating their membership. Membership Classes

The University of Michigan Flyers offers three regular classes of membership described below and one temporary class designed primarily for full-time students.

REGULAR CLASSES:

Flying: This class is allowed to rent aircraft and have voting privileges at the annual membership meeting. Flying dues are \$55 per month.

Associate: This class is welcome at social events and receives club mailings, but does not have voting or aircraft rental privileges. Dues are \$25 per year. This class is intended for people who choose to stop flying for a period of time, have their own aircraft or move out of town.

Family: This class is open to legally married spouses of a current Flying member or a current Flying member's dependent children or wards under the age of 21 years. The current Flying member pays regular Flying dues and has voting privileges, the other Family members share all rights and responsibilities of Flying members, but have no voting privileges and cannot hold club office. Dues for Family members are \$15 per month and all members must pay the standard Flying member initiation fees and security deposits.

TEMPORARY CLASS:

Non-Flying: This temporary class is open to full-time students at accredited schools, colleges or universities for a period not to exceed nine (9) months. Non-Flying members retain their voting rights but may not rent aircraft. Dues are \$5 per month. This class is intended to accommodate members who cannot participate in flying due to circumstances such as out-of-town college commitments. Other "non full-time student" members suffering from a temporary disability (i.e. loss of medical, license suspension, extended out-of-town business commitments) may petition the Board of Directors in writing to request Non-Flying status.

Financial Considerations for Class Changes

Fees and credits associated with various status change permutations are described below:

Flying to Associate: Member's security deposit is refunded and the \$25 yearly dues billed in advance

Flying to Non-Flying: Member will be billed the \$5 monthly dues at the start of the next month. After nine (9) months, the member will be changed to Associate status if no further action is taken by the member.

Associate to Flying: Member must pay the Flying class initiation fee and security deposit (only if this is the first time the member has been a Flying member), and pro-rated first month's dues.

Associate to Non-Flying: Not permitted.

Flying to Family: All new Family members must pay the Flying member initiation fee and security deposit and pro-rated first month's Family member dues (\$15 per month).

Non-Flying to Flying: Member must pay pro-rated first month's dues in advance.

Non-Flying to Associate: Member security deposit will be credited to account and the \$25 yearly dues assessed in advance.

Terminating membership: Member must settle all accounts with the club and return keys. The member's security deposit will then be refunded.
